How many rig contracts have been suspended by Aramco?

Considering that the offshore drilling company Valaris, through its joint venture ARO Drilling, received a notice of suspension from Aramco for its VALARIS 143 jack-up rig, with similar suspension issued by Aramco for Borr Drilling's jack-up rig Arabia I, this brings the total of rig contract suspension to 18 so far.

What happened to Saudi Aramco rigs?

Main Pass IV and Shelf Drilling Achiever contracts with Saudi Aramco have been terminated. Both rigs are being mobilized to West Africa due to arrive in September 2024 for contract opportunities commencing in Q4 2024. Baltic has completed its contract in Nigeria and is held for sale.

How many rigs does Aramco have?

As the most recent contracting round concludes, Aramco will boast of a jack-up drilling fleet of 78 rigs, most of which are being contracted on multi-year contracts ranging from three to five year charters, Westwood said. Aramco is also expected to tender for 10 additional offshore rigs, but the timeline for the new tender is not yet clear.

Who won Aramco Rig contracts?

Other Aramco contract winners for up to two to three rigs each include Arabian Drilling, Seadrill, COSL, Saipem, Valaris and Borr Drilling, the report said. Jack-up dayrates for the Saudi rig contracts have firmed up to between \$78,000 to \$98,000 apiece, significantly higher than the previous dayrates, it added.

Why is Aramco expanding its offshore rig?

Aramco's ambitious offshore rig expansion comes at a time when the company has reported a record quarterly profit of \$39.5 billion from soaring oil prices. Saudi Arabia is rapidly scaling up its oil production, with Aramco expected to boost its production capacity to 13 million barrels per day by 2027, up from the present 12 million bpd capacity.

Did Saudi Aramco suspend High Island IV rig?

Saudi Aramco suspended High Island IV (Shelf Drilling), Arabia II (Borr Drilling), Sneferu (DPS/Egyptian Drilling), and High Island II (Shelf Drilling) in November. Meanwhile, the report also noted that ultra-deepwater rig marketed utilization has fallen below its pre-pandemic peak.
