When did Cactus rigs go out of business?

In August 2002, the company sold those assets to Unit Drilling. "With a handful of employees and plenty of drilling equipment remaining, we fired up again almost immediately, and the current incarnation of our organization, Cactus Drilling Company LLC, was operational by the summer of 2003," Simons says. Today, Cactus operates a fleet of 58 rigs.

Where are cactus drilling rigs located?

Coterra Energy is the top operator with 23 wells, and Lea County, NM, is the most active drilling location with 9 wells. The most utilized rigs include Cactus 162 and Cactus 140, each drilling 7 wells, reflecting strong and consistent demand for Cactus Drilling's services.

Who is cactus drilling?

Cactus is a mid-size, U.S. domestic land drilling contractor providing quality people operating premium rigs to deliver safe and reliable results. As of March 2025 Cactus Drilling has drilled 120 wells year-to-date across Texas, Oklahoma, New Mexico, and Louisiana, with Texas leading at 64 wells.

"All are drilling for oil and liquids-rich gas," he says. Cactus' 58-rig fleet consists of two mechanical rigs, 31 Tier 2-B, SCR conventional rigs, 20 Tier 2-A SCR Rocket Rigs and five Tier 1 AC Rocket Rigs, Simons says. "We specialize in 1,500 horsepower rigs, with 85 percent of our fleet in that power range," he states.
