The Caspian Explorer is a drilling vessel designed specifically for use in the shallow northern Caspian Sea where traditional deep-water rigs cannot be used. We believe it to be the only vessel of its type operating in the Caspian Sea.

Will the Caspian explorer drill a well in 2023?

In March 2023 however, the Caspian Explorer acquired its first drilling contract. This likely led to the current \$22.5m purchase price for 50% of the shares. The Isatay Operating Company will utilise the vessel for the drilling of a well at a depth of 2,500m, with drilling set to begin in 2024.
