Are oil and gas rig accidents increasing?

If you have been reading the headlines of late, you will notice an increase in the reports of accidents involving oil and gas rig drilling operations. You also may have noticed these incidents are not occurring in the traditional oil and gas fields of America.

What are the hazards associated with drilling rigs?

This safety alert highlights the hazards associated with drilling rigs and the action required to manage these hazards. A 35-year-old worker died after his clothing was tangled on the rotating auger of the drilling rig he was operating. Drilling rigs present many hazards, including: hot hydraulic hoses inflicting burn injuries.

What is the biggest oil rig accident in the world?

The Piper Alpha Oil Rig disaster, in 1988, is the world's deadliest and most costly oil rig accident, with an estimated cost of \$3.4 Billion. At that time, Piper Alpha Oil was the largest oil producer in the world, capable of producing 317,000 barrels of oil per day.

Did drilling mud block natural gas from exiting a 4,000 m well?

Pressure from adding drilling mud and weighted liquids were insufficient to offset and block explosive natural gas from exiting the 4,000 m well, the U.S. Chemical Safety & Hazard Investigation Board (CSB) said on Aug. 16 in a factual update of its ongoing investigation.
