What are oil drilling rig crew members?

These service crews generally include directional drilling, well loggers, mud suppliers & mud engineers, analysis and treatment, cementing, casing, wireline operations, etc. In this article, we are discussing the oil drilling rig crew members organization chart including a task description of each personnel.

How many rig personnel are there?

The type and number of rig personnel is related to the size and complexity of the rig. At the simplest level, a basic rig includes a toolpusher, a driller, a derrickman, a motorman, and a floorhand. The toolpusher is the senior manager at the rig and is responsible for personnel, parts, and performance.

How do rig personnel work?

On large, complex rigs, additional personnel are required. A representative from the client company called the drilling foreman or company man is typically present on the rig. The company representative is in charge of all drilling operations at the wellsite, including safety. On offshore and remote land locations, rig personnel stay at the wellsite.

What is the chain of command in a drilling rig?

The chain of command in a drilling rig is usually filled with personnel or crew of varying degrees of experience. Those at the top have generally had experience in all phases of the drilling rig operations. Those with the least experience usually perform specific duties requiring limited training.

Where do rig personnel stay?

On offshore and remote land locations, rig personnel stay at the wellsite. Additional personnel that provide services such as welding and electrical work are also housed at the wellsite, along with personnel to house, feed, and care for the crew. An example of the general organization required to run a complex operation is given in Figure 1.
