



# Drilling rig floorhand salary

How can a floor hand become a rig manager?

A Floor Hand can advance to higher positions on a rig through experience and additional training. Potential career paths include roles such as Motorhand, Derrickhand, and Driller. With further experience and possibly additional education, advancing to a Rig Manager or other supervisory positions is also achievable.

How much do oil rig managers make?

Drillers earn approximately \$34-\$44 per hour. Lastly, you can eventually make it to the senior-most position on an oil rig: The Rig Manager. This role requires years of experience but it is certainly not outside of your reach. Rig Managers can earn a salary of over \$90,000 per year.

How much do floor hands make?
