How much does a drill rig operator make?

The average Drill Rig Operator salary in the United States is \$43,509 as of March 28, 2023, but the salary range typically falls between \$42,309 and \$47,782. Over the past five years, oil rig worker salaries have shown steady improvement following the industry's slump in 2021 and 2022. The year 2024 marked a shift, with more oil field workers seeing salary increases than pay freezes. Today, 50% of professionals report earning more than the year before, and 26% received pay rises above five per cent.

The materials used in making a drill rig are a key component in construction costs. The material used most, steel, comes in various strengths, and the stronger the steel, the higher it's priced. When steel prices are low, rigs will be cheaper to produce; when steel prices rise, so do the costs of the rigs.
