How much does a drill rig operator make?

The average Drill Rig Operator salary in the United States is \$43,509 as of March 28, 2023, but the salary range typically falls between \$42,309 and \$47,782. Salary ranges can vary widely depending on many important factors, including education, certifications, additional skills, the number of years you have spent in your profession.

How much do oil rig jobs pay?

We've identified 29 states where the typical salary for an Oil Rig job is above the national average. Topping the list is Newfoundland, with Northwest Territories and Quebec close behind in second and third. Quebec beats the national average by 66.2%, and Newfoundland furthers that trend with another \$31,972 (67.7%) above the \$47,194.

How much do oil drillers make?

The national average salary for a driller is \$63,015 per year, and the salary range for drillers is \$43,519 to \$91,246 per year. Oil drillers may also receive many benefits, including health insurance, flexible spending accounts and dental insurance. Salary figures reflect data listed on Indeed Salaries at time of writing.

How much does an oil rig welder make?
