



## Drilling rig wages 2017

How much do oil rig workers make a year?

Duties include cleaning work areas and bringing supplies to equipment operators at an average annual salary of \$38,140. Oil rigs need trained workers to operate oil pumping systems and regulate the flow of oil from wells to pipelines. They must control pipe manifolds for consistent flow.

How much do rotary drill operators make?

Derrick operators earn an average salary of \$47,680 per year. Rotary drill operators are specialists in the safe handling of drills and recommended drill speeds. They make an average salary of \$64,110 per year. Roustabouts assemble oil field equipment and promptly make repairs to ensure uninterrupted production around the clock.
