Are oil rig workers getting paid more?

Over the past five years, oil rig worker salaries have shown steady improvement following the industry's slump in 2021 and 2022. The year 2024 marked a shift, with more oil field workers seeing salary increases than pay freezes. Today, 50% of professionals report earning more than the year before, and 26% received pay rises above five per cent.

How much does an oil rig operator make?

Oil rig positions responsible for oil extraction on offshore oil drilling installations are: service unit operators, rotary drill operators, and derrick operators. These positions require not only experience, but also education and on-site training. Median annual salary for them ranges between \$US 47,000 to \$US 64,000.

How much do rig workers make a year?

To make the picture as complete as possible, in year 2011 the average salary for rig workers and other industry personnel was slightly over \$US 99,000 a year, while greenhorn personnel with less than 12 months experience (read 6 months) the average wage was almost \$US 67,000.

How much does an oil rig welder make?

See below for figures on what an oil rig welder salary can look like according to region: For QA/QC inspectors, salaries range from \$43,200 to \$154,012 depending on location and experience. Often, offshore oil rig jobs pay higher than land-based roles due to the hazardous nature of the work.
