How many oil and gas wells have been drilled in California?

California statewide summary oil and gas data that goes back to 1977 and contains information on the 239,646 wells that have been drilled in the state since that time. California is ranked #5 in the US based on Barrels of Oil Equivalent (BOE) produced in Aug 2024.

How many oil rigs are there in the US?

The June 20th Baker Hughes rig count report shows a drop in the active rig count. Baker Hughes reports 554 active drilling rigs in the US. In April, the total active rig count was 587. One year ago, the total active rig count was 588. The oil rig count is currently 438 rigs, compared to 483 in April and 485 one year ago.

Where does oil drilling take place in California?

All oil drilling into the South Ellwood Offshore field takes place from Platform Holly, about two miles (3 km) offshore in state waters 34.3898°N 119.9065°W. Oil wells on wharves built out over the ocean, Summerland oil field, 1902. Offshore oil and gas in California provides a significant portion of the state's petroleum production.

What is a drilling rig?

A drilling rig is an apparatus constructed for oil drilling. The term "rig" generally refers to the equipment used to penetrate the Earth's crust. Oil and natural gas drilling rigs are used to identify geologic reservoirs and create holes to extract oil or natural gas from those reservoirs.

How many rigs are there?

On June 19, 2020, the number of active rigs was 266, the lowest since the Baker Hughes Company started collecting data in 1987. Since then, the number of rigs has grown quite a bit. As of mid-2023, the number of rigs totals approximately 740.

How many offshore drilling platforms are there in California?

Twenty seven platforms lie along the Southern California coast from Huntington Beach to Point Conception in Santa Barbara County. Twenty-three offshore drilling and production platforms are in federal waters at depths that range from 100 to 1,200 feet.
