How much does well drilling cost?

Well drilling prices range from \$30 to \$80+per footfor a complete installation or \$20 to \$30 per foot just to drill. Expect to pay significantly more when digging in remote areas or through rocky,sloped,dry,or low-quality soil. The table below shows the average well drilling and well system installation costs for various depths.
