Is Maersk Drilling about to shrink its rig fleet?

Maersk Drilling looks set to shrink its rig fleet further, with the next cull victim expected to be the semi-submersible Maersk Explorer. The Danish drilling contractor confirmed it is investigating recycling opportunities for its 2003-built unit, which is cold-stacked in Azerbaijan.

What is a Maersk explorer rig?

The Maersk Explorer rig was built and delivered in 2003 by Caspian Shipyard Company and KeppelFELS. The rig is designed for year-round operations at water depths from 40m to 1,000m (147ft to 3,280ft). This is the third rig to be named Maersk Explorer, but the previous two were both jack-up rigs and are no longer a part of the Maersk fleet.

When did Maersk Drilling get a contract extension?

In July 2015, Maersk Drilling signed a contract extension for the rig with BP. The new 5-year contract worth around \$523 million was a direct continuation of the contract which was supposed to end in May 2016. The Maersk Explorer rig was built and delivered in 2003 by Caspian Shipyard Company and KeppelFELS.

Why did Maersk Drilling change its name?

Maersk Drilling told Offshore Energy Today that the rig name was changed back to its original one, Maersk Explorer, about a month ago, per agreement with the relevant authorities in Azerbaijan. The company did not say what the reason for the name change was.

What is a Maersk explorer?

It was a Marine 306 jack-up later sold to Pride and converted to an accommodation unit named the Pride Rotterdam, now the Atlantic Rotterdam. The latest of the Maersk Explorers, that is, the current one, was named in Baku on July 24, 2003, and later was given the local name Lider, meaning "leader" in Azeri.

Who is Maersk Drilling?

Maersk Drilling, also known as The Drilling Company of 1972 A/S, was the drilling-rig operator of Maersk. It was based in Lyngby, Denmark. Established in 1972, the company was a Nasdaq Copenhagen -listed company with the ticket name 'DRLCO'.
