



## Number of rigs drilling in alberta

How many rigs drilling for oil in Canada?

More recently, on 10 July 2020 there were 6 rigs drilling for oil in Canada. In June the number of rigs drilling for either oil or gas averaged 18 per day, the lowest number since at least 1964, when data for all Canadian drilling was first recorded. Global investment in oil and gas has decreased significantly because of much lower oil prices.

Where are Canadian oil rigs located?

Date Canadian oil drilling activity is primarily centered in Alberta and Saskatchewan and is heavily influenced by prevailing market conditions and prices. Alberta accounted for about 70% of the total annual average rig count vs 30% Saskatchewan.

How many rigs are there in Alberta?

Alberta recorded an average of 187 active rigs in 2012 and the count decreased steadily to just 35 rigs in 2016. The average annual rig count has fluctuated between 30 and 80 in subsequent years to average about 70, with the exception of the 2020 pandemic year where just 27 rigs were recorded.

Are rigs drilling for oil a seasonal trend in Canada?

Rigs drilling for oil display a seasonal pattern in Canada. In 2019, rigs drilling for oil increased from 17 at the beginning of May to 84 by the last week of June. Over the same time period in 2020, rigs drilling for oil in Canada decreased from 7 to 4. Canadian oil rig activity differs from the U.S. because Canadian drilling is largely seasonal.

How many oil rigs are there in Saskatchewan?

The average annual rig count has fluctuated between 30 and 80 in subsequent years to average about 70, with the exception of the 2020 pandemic year where just 27 rigs were recorded. Saskatchewan has experienced a relatively stable oil rig count compared to Alberta.
