Who owns the ocean Valiant drilling rig?

The Ocean Valiant drilling rig is owned by Diamond Offshore which can be contacted for jobs and careers on the Ocean Valiant. The Semisub is a Semisub type of rig and is designed as a ODECO Ocean Odyssey and built by Hyundai Heavy Ind. at the Hyundai, Ulsan, Korea shipyard.

Who owns Ocean Valiant?

Built in 1988, the oil platform is owned by Diamond Offshore and was en route to Turkey to be scrapped. On the night of January 11, the 119 meter long drilling rig/oil platform Ocean Valiant (IMO: 8753330) ran aground in the Mediterranean Sea at Dherwa beach 20 kilometers west of Bizerte, Tunisia.

Will Diamond Offshore release Ocean Valiant rig from its contract?

Shell and Diamond Offshore have "mutually agreed" the release of the Ocean Valiant rig from its contract. Diamond's most recent fleet status report, published in February, shows Ocean Valiant was supposed to be with Shell in the UK North Sea from November 2019 until March 2021.

What happened to Ocean Valiant?

On the night of January 11, the 119 meter long drilling rig/oil platform Ocean Valiant (IMO: 8753330) ran aground in the Mediterranean Sea at Dherwa beach 20 kilometers west of Bizerte, Tunisia. The Ocean Valiant was being towed by a offshore supply vessel Maersk Tracer (IMO: 9388613) from Scotland bound for Turkey when rough weather

What happened to the ocean Valiant rig?

Once an industry workhorse, the rig had been out of service since 2020. Diamond Offshore, recently merged with Noble Corporation, had earmarked the Ocean Valiant for dismantling, following the earlier scrapping of another rig, the Ocean Monarch. This event serves as a stark reminder of the challenges involved in towing large offshore structures.

Why did shell release the ocean Valiant rig?

It's understood the Ocean Valiant decision was "operational" and not linked to any spending reductions which may be triggered by the current crude price slump.
