



Rigid drill chuck stuck

What is a Ridgid Chuck?

This replacement chuck is a genuine Ridgid part that is designed for use with electric drills. It allows the user to secure a drill bit with its ratcheting action, which clicks the jaws tightly into place for reduced bit slippage.

How do I fix a stuck Chuck?

use a strap wrench - the only way to do this was to grip around the chuck and run the drill in the opposite direction. As the drill bit was so stuck and the drill torque was so high it was the drill (rather than the chuck) that started to rotate and started moving towards drilling into my arm!

How do you fix a stuck drill chuck?

If the chuck is stuck open, check that the screw inside the drill chuck is fasten tight. If it is loose, it can prevent movement of the teeth. To solve this problem, insert the proper screwdriver in the drill chuck and tighten. Remember, this screw is reversed thread so turn it counter clockwise to tighten. If...

How do you open a Ridd Chuck?

This is a notorious problem, (you'd think RIDGID would have something on their website) but the solution is to slightly turn the rear collar to open then put a 7/8" wrench on the shaft behind the collar and finally, carefully turn the chuck CCW with a pair of pump pliers avoiding scoring it. Doug.. GREAT...

How do you remove a drill chuck?

On every drill I've looked at, the chuck is attached by a screw located behind the jaws, so can't be removed if there is a bit in place (or if the jaws are tightly closed). Hold the base part of the drill chuck with your hand. Hit to the head of the drill chuck with a hammer in the direction you would turn the head to remove.

What happens if a drill chuck is damaged?

Even if the finish is damaged, the chuck will still function, but you may need to always use gloves on it because the damaged surface will be too harsh for bare skin. If the drill doesn't torque enough to loosen the chuck, you may need to use two tools to get it to loosen. It will loosen with the right tools.

To remove the chuck from a Ridgid cordless drill, you will need to hold the drill securely and rotate the chuck counterclockwise. Most Ridgid ...
