

How do oil-injected twin screw compressors work?

Compressors where oil-free compressors have been installed. Oil-injected twin screw compressors operate with oil injection into the rotor chamber, which is used for cooling, sealing of the clearance gaps and lubrication of the rotors - in which, the directly driven male rotor drives the female rotor using the injected oil as a hydrodynamic

What is a leakage path in a twin screw compressor?

Figure 2: Twin screw compressor operation. Leakage paths The main clearance gaps in a twin screw compressor that create a path through which leakage can occur are: the rotor to casing 'axial' gap, the rotor to casing 'radial' gap and the rotor to rotor 'interlobe' gap. Figure 3 displays these main leakage paths.

What type of compressor is a screw compressor?

Screw compressors are categorized as intermittent motion compressors (non-continuous flow). They can also be categorized with medium flow and medium pressure compressors compared with other types of compressors on pressure /flow chart for compressor types.

How does a compressed air compressor work?

The compressed air is compressed with oil (flooded type) inside the compressor, and then the compressed oil and air are introduced to an oil separation unit to separate oil and air. Then the air is removed to the discharge line and oil is returned to the oil filter for filtration, then to the suction of compressor again.

Why is my air compressor not working properly?

Filters and contaminants Torn or blocked air suction filters can cause serious damage to the compressor because if it is saturated with dust or oil, the air flow will bypass it and enter the compressor with dust causing scratches on the screws.
