



Setting up a 22w drill rig

What is a 22 W drill?

The 22-W is a three-line drill with standard components for a modern cable-tool-type. It includes a bull-reel for the drill line, a sand reel for the bailing line, and a casing reel for the hoist line, typically connected to a traveling block or moveable pulley and a hook.

Is setting up a drilling rig an art?

How much does a 22W rig weigh?

A 22-W rig produced since the 1960s, which is a Series II version, is rated at 2,500 pounds at the surface for tools on the intermediate stroke. However, its weight on the long stroke is approximately 1,900 pounds.

How many strokes does a 22 W drill have?

The 22-W drills have three adjustable strokes: a short 16-inch stroke, an intermediate 26-inch stroke, and a long 35-inch stroke. The 22-W drills have three strokes.

Is a drilling rig a site dependent skill?

It's often stated the art of setting up a drilling rig and the proper site preparation that precedes it are site dependent. No two sites are the same. As the industry offers safety resources that outline basic guidelines for mobilizing, setting up, and demobilizing (see shaded box below), these skills are most learned on site.

How to operate a 22W cable reel?

To operate the cable reels on a 22-W, Bucyrus-Erie has developed a method that allows the driller to run both the bull reel, which carries the drilling line, and the casing reel with one clutch. This is done by sliding the drive gear (or pinion) to the desired reel.

Likewise, the 22W is a rig that will drill a 4-inch domestic well, a 6-inch to 8-inch well for a farm, a 10-inch or 12-inch for an irrigation project, and if it is reasonably shallow, a 16-inch ...
