How does Texas Track oil & gas drilling permits?

AUSTIN- The Railroad Commission of Texas this week launches two more interactive data maps showing oil and gas drilling permit approvals and the number of wells spudded, which is when operators begin drilling a well. Information is displayed by counts, operators, county locations and on a statewide level.

The data is available 24-hours a day, seven days a week beginning with Calendar Year 2018. "With this latest interactive data on the Commission's drilling permit approvals and wells spudded, our agency is providing more detailed insight into Texas' energy industry," said Wei Wang, RRC's Executive Director.

How many oil and gas wells have been drilled in Texas?

Texas statewide summary oil and gas data that goes back to 1993 and contains information on the 700,556 wells that have been drilled in the state since that time. Texas is ranked #1 in the US based on Barrels of Oil Equivalent (BOE) produced in Apr 2025.

What is a drilling rig?

A drilling rig is an apparatus constructed for oil drilling. The term "rig" generally refers to the equipment used to penetrate the Earth's crust. Oil and natural gas drilling rigs are used to identify geologic reservoirs and create holes to extract oil or natural gas from those reservoirs.
