What does an oil rig tool pusher do?

An oil rig tool pusher works in the oil drilling industry. It is often a leadership and foreperson position. Inventory duties are often given to the tool pusher to ensure that supplies are always available. Since this is usually a supervisory experience, many years of experience working on an oil rig are usually needed.

Can a driller be a tool pusher?

Who does a tool pusher report to?

A tool pusher reports to the Rig Superintendent when onshore or the Offshore Installation Manager (OIM) when offshore. Who works under their command? A toolpusher is the second-in-command on the drilling rig and manages all personnel on the rig except his superior: the drilling superintendent.

A tool pusher (sometimes toolpusher, pusher, or The Push) is an occupation within the oil drilling industry.
