What is a cable tool rig?

Cable tool rigs are ideal for initial water well development, water well redevelopment, and water well rehabilitation. From 2 in. monitoring wells to 7,000 GPM large diameter wells, cable tool drilling is proven for installing the most efficient wells. Cable tool drilling is free of drilling fluids or additives, which can cause formation plugging.

What is cable tool drilling?

Cable tool drilling is free of drilling fluids or additives, which can cause formation plugging. Our founder, Randy Holt, founded his clean water drilling business using cable tool drilling. He has operated cable tool rigs for over 30 years and has installed wells which produced over 7,000 GPM.

How does a cable drilling rig work?

It is a very old technique, slow but steady and only requires one person to operate the rig. A derrick is raised to support the cable tool. The cable tool is a drilling "bit" that is repeatedly raised and dropped in the hole to break up any formation encountered. Then the cable tool is swapped out and a bailer is lowered into the hole.

Where did cable tool rigs come from?

Cable tool rigs were originally used in the United States for drilling water wells in the early 1800s but had their origins in the percussive drilling techniques used by ancient Chinese and Persian civilizations. They were adapted in the mid- to late-1800s for drilling hydrocarbon wells.
