What is a drilling rig?

The term "rig" therefore generally refers to the complex equipment that is used to penetrate the surface of the Earth's crust. Small to medium-sized drilling rigs are mobile, such as those used in mineral exploration drilling, blast-hole, water wells and environmental investigations.

Oil and Gas Drilling Rigs: These are large, often towering structures used to extract oil and natural gas from deep underground reservoirs. **Water Well Drilling Rigs:** Smaller rigs designed to drill wells for water extraction. **Geotechnical Drilling Rigs:** Used for soil sampling and testing in construction projects.

How does a drill rig work?

Drilling the Hole: Once the rig is set up, the drill bit is lowered into the earth. The bit spins rapidly, cutting through soil, rock, and other materials as it goes deeper. **Using Drilling Mud:** To keep the drilling bit cool and clear of debris, a special fluid called drilling mud is pumped down into the hole.
